Madame Bollinger created the first legendary vintage in 1967 with the launch of R.D. 1952. Bollinger R.D. is the result of Madame Bollinger's great vision: an expert wine with aromas enhanced by its exceptionally long maturation in the Bollinger family's cellars. Bollinger R.D. is James Bond's favourite champagne and ready to enjoy now.

Blend: 2002 vintage: 60% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay. 71% Grands crus, 29% Premiers crus.

Only the very best among vintage champagnes become Bollinger R.D. and 2002 is definitely one of the most promising vintages of the last decade.

Maturation: Very long maturation, more than three times longer than required by the appellation, for an infinite array of flavours: a true wine alchemy.

Dosage: Very low: "Extra Brut", 3 to 4 grams per litre.
