ON THE EYE:

The Lanson 1976 displays an old gold colour.

ON THE NOSE:

At first the nose evokes undergrowth and lime; then, on swirling the glass, the aromas of dried fig, mirabelle plum and prune are released.

ON THE PALATE:

The initial impact is robust, well-rounded, rich and long. The mint and citrus notes contribute to the final freshness.

ACCOMPANIMENT:

I recommend pairing this with a white truffle risotto which is sublime.

BLEND:

*53% Chardonnay,
47% Pinot Noir.*
