WEATHER CONDITIONS

The growing season began with a warm spring which transitioned into a hot June which ensured both a successful budburst and flowering. Conversely, July was cool and claggy with the weather warming up again in August, although the month still saw some serious downpours. The heavy rains cut yields and when it came to the September harvest, we had to carefully pick to avoid rotted or damaged grapes. However, despite these difficulties, the harvest was largely a success despite being smaller than usual. The result was extremely balanced grapes with a perfect equilibrium between freshness and maturity.

BLEND: 50% Chardonnay / 50% Pinot Noir

DOSAGE: 5.2g/l
